The authors have addressed well the previous comment, however I was a bit disappointed not to see the method applied in real image of biological samples, which will be a lot harder than those used in the current paper. The study, although useful, would have more impact when tested on those image. Thus a bit disclaimer in the title and discussion of the "more theoretical" nature of the manuscript is needed.
